Denver police have arrested a suspect who reportedly entered Montbello High School carrying a gun, officials say.

A school security officer spotted the person who was not authorized to be in the school, Denver Public Schools spokesman Alex Sanchez said. The suspect then fled, he said.

Police were called at 9:54 a.m. and chased the suspect down and arrested him, Sanchez said. The school was placed in lockdown while authorities searched for the gun, he said.

No weapon was found, said Detective John White, Denver police spokesman.

The identity of the suspect has not been released.

Montbello was taken off lockdown at 2:08 p.m., Sanchez said.

Montbello High School was placed on lockdown for several hours Tuesday as police searched for weapons.

A person whose name was not released was spotted by a school resource officer as an unauthorized individual.

"They wear uniforms at Montbello, so it's easy to identify who does not belong," said Alex Sanchez, spokesman for Denver Public Schools.

Sanchez said that the person was caught by Denver police. He said it wasn't known where the suspect entered the campus but that police did not find any weapons.

Sanchez said he was notified of the lockdown about 1 p.m. and that it was lifted about 2 p.m.

DENVER – Montbello High School went into lockdown on Tuesday afternoon after police were told that someone may have brought a gun to school.

Denver Police originally responded to the school after a fight was reported around 10 a.m. The situation was resolved and no one was arrested.

Then officers were told about a possible gun and an unauthorized person on campus. That person was taken into custody around 1 p.m.

The school was put into lockdown while officers searched the school.

DENVER -- Montbello High School in Denver is on lockdown on the report that a person with a gun may be inside the school.

Denver police Detective John White told 7NEWS that officers were called to the school just before 10 a.m.

At that time, one person was taken into custody but released a short time later.

After releasing the person, Denver police said they found out there may have been someone with a gun in the school.

Montbello was put on lockdown while police searched for the gun. It had not been found.

A father called 7NEWS for information about the lockdown after his daughter sent him a text message from class. The daughter told her father that the school was in lockdown but students were not being given any more information.
