## NEW AUTOMATED MESSAGE SYSTEM

### FAST FACTS

- **Text messages will come from phone number 675-87.** If you've received messages through SchoolMessenger from another school district in the past, it may show up as a saved contact.
- **You will receive messages based on your preferences in Infinite Campus (IC),** including contact method and language preferences.
- **Adjust your preferences in the DPS Parent and Student Portals.**



DPS is starting to use a new system to alert families when there is an emergency at school. Starting mid-November, we will begin using SchoolMessenger to send emergency messages to parent and guardian contacts, as well as high school students who have signed up to receive them. These messages include:

- Text, email and phone communications related to school closures, early releases or late starts
- Messages about lockdowns or lockouts

**Look for a welcome message from SchoolMessenger in mid-November, which will come as a text, phone call or email, based on your preferences in Infinite Campus (IC).** Schools will continue to use IC Messenger until DPS fully transitions to SchoolMessenger for school-based communications during a later phase.
